#### **Key Activities**

#### Management and Administration

Attended and contributed to the full and mini-PDT meetings and other management group meetings in order to provide feedback to project team. Provided input regarding issues and concerns of project sponsors and setting of the January SASS agendas.

Planned and managed the two FTA/FHWA conference call/meetings in January. Coordinated with Tri-Met and other project team members to set agenda and prepare for teleconferences. Worked with transit task lead and New Starts Group to discuss feedback/comments from FTA regarding initiation package. Assisted in preparation of additional responses to FTA based on modeling questions from FTA staff in D.C.

Met with RTC management and other staff for briefing on project status and emerging issues to be addressed by the project sponsor agencies. Met with CRC Team members to outline needs and potential issues in preparation for 2/6/07 RTC Board meeting. Attended January SASS meeting and briefed RTC Director on key issues prior to the meeting.

#### Communications

Participated in training session for the January Open Houses for CRC. Staffed the January 20 Open House at Lincoln School in Vancouver and the January 25<sup>th</sup> Open House at OAME in Portland. Provided initial feedback and input to the CRC newsletter and the I-5 Bridge Reuse Folio.

#### Transportation and Transit

Participated in and provided feedback to CRC staff at the regular Transit and Modeling work group meetings.

Held several meetings with CRC Project Director and Project Engineer to discuss EMME2 license upgrade required for RTC to lead the transit coding element for Phase II of the CRC Project. After initial approval from WSDOT, RTC worked with INRO to proceed on license upgrade process. Approval of amendment to the RTC/WSDOT IGA for license upgrade cost is scheduled for RTC Board action on 2/6/07.

Worked with the Transit Task Manager and the Transit Work Group to narrow build concepts and define the initial BRT and LRT options for travel forecasting. Discussion

with project staff and modeling staff from Metro and RTC included outline of travel forecasting needs and sequence of initial No Build and Build model runs.

Attended special meeting of the Transit Work Group for initial discussion and identification of modeling issues that need resolution by technical staff and consensus from key partner agency management staff.

Participated in initial TNET review of the No Build and Build transit alternatives. Reviewed and prepared detailed transit line data for coding of the No Build transit alternative. Reviewed zonal connections in central Vancouver to transit lines to insure boarding access. Compiled park and ride data from Phase I for preparation/refinement of park and ride sheds in Phase II of the CRC Project.

Held additional meetings with Clark County planning staff on Clark County control totals and allocation for 2030 households and employment and got their concurrence on the zone-by-zone allocation. Began preparation of zonal data for forwarding to Metro. Refined methodology with Metro to resolve Clark County control total differences between Clark County GMA and Metroscope processes.
